Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule

LSA Document #17-553

Under [IC 4-22-2-23](#), the Natural Resources Commission intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Amends [312 IAC 3-1-7](#) to establish a time deadline applicable to filings determined by date of delivery or receipt, to eliminate filing by facsimile, and make other technical amendments. Amends [312 IAC 3-1-9](#) to clarify the authority of the secretary of the natural resources commission to affirm a nonfinal order issued by an administrative law judge approving an agreed order entered by the parties when the administrative law judge is not the ultimate authority. Repeals [312 IAC 1-1-7](#), [312 IAC 1-1-8](#), [312 IAC 1-1-9](#), [312 IAC 1-1-10](#), [312 IAC 1-1-11](#), [312 IAC 1-1-12](#), [312 IAC 1-1-19.5](#), and [312 IAC 3-1-16](#).
