**OVERVIEW:** Amends <u>846 IAC 1-3-3</u> and <u>846 IAC 1-8-1</u> to establish health and sanitation standards for dry needling that conform to public health standards for dry needling, and to specify continuing education required for a chiropractor to conduct dry needling and for each biennial license renewal period.
