Under [IC 4-22-2-24](#), [IC 13-14-8-6](#), and [IC 13-14-9](#), notice is hereby given that on February 9, 2022, at 1:30 p.m., at the Indiana Government Center South, 10 North Senate Avenue, Conference Center Room A, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Environmental Rules Board (board) will hold a public hearing on amendments to [326 IAC 1-4](#), concerning updates to the attainment designation status for ninety Indiana counties under the primary and secondary National Ambient Air Quality Standards for sulfur dioxide, as well as updates to [326 IAC 1-4-65](#) to change the designation status for Porter County under the 2015 8-hour ozone standard.
