Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule

LSA Document #22-142

Under [IC 4-22-2-23](#), the Division of Family Resources intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Adds [470 IAC 15](#) concerning processing of claims for reimbursement for funeral and cemetery costs, and to list the requirements that funeral and cemetery providers must meet to obtain reimbursement for claims, including the requirement that funeral and cemetery providers must submit their claims to the Division of Family Resources within 90 days of the date of death of the decedent, and the requirement that funeral and cemetery providers must report additional monies received within 90 days of receipt. Statutory authority: [IC 12-13-5-3](#).
