DIGEST

Temporarily establishes counties and the statewide quota for the trapping of river otters during the 2022-2023 river otter season. Effective November 15, 2022.

SECTION 1. (a) This SECTION is supplemental to [312 IAC 9-3-18.2](#).

(b) An individual may take a river otter as authorized in [312 IAC 9-3-18.2](#) in the following counties only:
