PURPOSE OF NOTICE

A Second Notice of Comment Period was published on December 21, 2022, in the Indiana Register (DIN: 2022121-IR-329210458SNA) concerning amendments to rules at 329 IAC 10-3-1, 329 IAC 10-3-4, and 329 IAC 10-9-1, and the addition of a new article at 329 IAC 14, concerning the establishment of a state permitting program for coal combustion residuals (CCR). In response to requests, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) is providing an additional sixty (60) days for submission of comments on the rulemaking. Comments submitted to IDEM from the original Second Notice of Comment Period are considered part of the formal written comment period.
