SUMMARY OF FINDINGS UNDER IC 4-22-2.6-4

This rulemaking is required under <u>IC 4-22-2.6</u>, which provides for the expiration and readoption of administrative rules. All rules expire on January 1 of the fifth year after the year in which each rule takes effect unless the rule expires or is repealed on an earlier date. The rules listed to be readopted have an expiration date of January 1, 2025, or later. Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) has chosen to readopt all articles in the Indiana Administrative Code at one time rather than readopt each rule separately as its expiration date approaches.

All the proposed readopted rules remain necessary and meet the standards set forth in <u>IC 4-22-2-19.5</u> and, where applicable, <u>IC 4-22-2-19.6</u>. No less costly or less intrusive alternative methods of achieving the purposes of the rules have been identified. The rules avoid duplicating standards found in state or federal law, are written for ease of comprehension for the entities subject to them, and have practicable enforcement. There have been no significant changes to the cost benefit, fiscal impact, or regulatory burden statements prepared for the initial adoption of the proposed readopted rules.
