# **SUMMARY OF FINDINGS UNDER IC 4-22-2.6-4**

The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) is proposing to readopt all rules in Title 328 regarding the Excess Liability Trust Fund (ELTF) without any proposed changes. All the rules proposed for readoption remain necessary and meet the standards set forth in <a href="LC 4-22-2-19.5">LC 4-22-2-19.5</a>. IDEM has determined that there is a continued need for the listed ELTF rules based on statutory requirements, federal financial assurance requirements for underground storage tanks, and the benefits of funding remediation for releases from underground storage tanks. The details of the ELTF program are described in more detail in the previously published legislative notice (20231220-IR-328230811LNA) for LSA Document #23-811.

No less costly or less intrusive alternative methods of achieving the purposes of the rules have been identified. The rules avoid duplicating standards found in state or federal law, are written for ease of comprehension for the entities subject to them, and have practicable enforcement. There have been no significant changes to the cost benefit, fiscal impact, or regulatory burden statements prepared for the initial adoption of the proposed readopted rules.
