Sec. 1. (a) The following persons shall report to the department each case in which the person treated a patient suffering from an abortion complication:

(1) A physician licensed under <u>IC 25-22.5</u>.

(2) A facility.

(b) In the case of a physician treating a patient at a facility, the physician and the facility are not required to separately report

the same abortion complication. The physician and the facility must have a process in place to assure that the required report is made in compliance with this rule and <u>IC 16-34-2-4.7</u>. (Indiana Department of Health; 410 IAC 41-2-1; filed Nov 4, 2022, 8:30 a.m.: 20221130-IR-410220074FRA)

410 IAC 41-2-2 Submission and contents of report

Sec. 2. (a) A report of an abortion complication shall be submitted to the department within thirty (30) calendar days of the date of the onset of treatment for the reported complication.

(b) The report shall:

(1) include the information required by <u>IC 16-34-2-4.7</u>; and

(2) be made on the form prescribed by the department.

(c) A new report shall be made for any follow-up visits in which a new abortion complication is diagnosed and treated.
