Nonrule Policy ATC-006

SUBJECT: The purpose of this nonrule policy is to implement a uniform procedure for the administration of in-state direct wine seller permit applications governed by the ATC.

SCOPE: The ATC may issue a direct wine seller's permit to an applicant who meets all the requirements outlined in [IC 7.1-3-26-7](#).

POLICY: Pursuant to [IC 7.1-3-26-7\(a\)\(7\)](#), the applicant shall complete all documentation regarding the applicant's application required by the commission. The applicant shall submit the following documents:

1. Application for new or transfer permit;
2. Supplement to application for new or transfer permit for direct wine seller's permit;
3. Surety bond; and
4. \$100 fee.

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
