Change of Previous Public Notice Regarding Changes in Statewide Methods and Standards for Setting Payments for Medicaid Enrolled Nursing Facilities

In accordance with the public notice requirements of 42 CFR 447.205, Section 1902(a)(13)(A) of the Social Security Act, the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA), Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) publishes this change of previous public notice regarding proposed changes to the reimbursement methodology for nursing facilities (NFs). The public notice posted on the Indiana Register website on June 3, 2020, at [20200603-IR-405200282ONA](#) is hereby withdrawn.

OMPP will not continue the three percent (3%) reduction that is currently set to expire on June 30, 2021, for rates paid to nursing facilities, under the Medicaid state plan and state regulations at [405 IAC 1-14.6](#).
