Temporarily adds rules concerning instant game number 394. Effective August 31, 2000.
SECTION 1. The name of this instant game is "Instant Game Number 394, Indiana Road Trip".
SECTION 2. Instant tickets in instant game number 394 shall sell for three dollars (\$3) per ticket.
SECTION 3. (a) Each instant ticket in instant game number 394 shall contain twenty-eight (28) play symbols and play symbol captions arranged among three (3) separate and independent games each concealed under a spot of latex material.
(b) The uppermost game shall contain twenty-two (22) play symbols and play symbol captions. The portion of the game play data area shaped like the state of Indiana shall contain twenty (20) play symbols and play symbol captions arranged in pairs of numbers and prize amounts. Each of the two (2) diamond-shaped boxes labeled "LUCKY NUMBER" shall contain one (1) play symbol and play symbol caption representing a number.
(c) The lower game on the left side of each instant ticket shall be labeled "LUNCH MONEY" and contain three (3) play symbols and play symbol captions.
(d) The lower game on the right side of each instant ticket shall be labeled "GAS MONEY" and contain three (3) play symbols and play symbols and play symbol captions.

SECTION 4. (a) The play symbols and play symbol captions representing prize amounts shall consist of the following possible play symbols and play symbol captions:

(d) The play symbols and play symbol captions appearing in the "GAS MONEY" game shall consist of the following possible play symbols and play symbol captions:

(4) A picture of a folded map MAP
(5) A picture of a telephone PHONE
(6) A picture of a sign SIGN

SECTION 5. The holder of a ticket in instant game number 394 shall remove the latex material covering the twenty-eight (28) play symbols and play symbol captions. If either of the "LUCKY NUMBER" play symbols match any of the numbers in the portion of the game play data area shaped like the state of Indiana, the holder is entitled to the paired prize amount. SECTION 6. (a) There shall be approximately three million one hundred thousand $(\mathbf{3}, \mathbf{1 0 0}, \mathbf{0 0 0})$ instant tickets initially available in instant game number 394.
(b) The odds of winning a prize in instant game number 394 are approximately $\mathbf{1}$ in $\mathbf{3 . 7 5}$.
(c) All reorders of tickets for instant game number 394 shall have the same:
(1) prize structure;
(2) number of prizes per prize pool of two hundred forty thousand $(\mathbf{2 4 0 , 0 0 0})$; and
(3) odds;
as contained in the initial order.
SECTION 7. The last day to claim a prize in instant game number 394 is February 28, 2001.
SECTION 8. SECTIONS 1 through 7 of this document expire April 30, 2001.
