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TITLE 760 DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE

DIGEST

Establishes the date by which persons regulated by the department of insurance must comply with the provisions of Title V of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act, 15 U.S.C. 6801 through 15 U.S.C. 6827, which requires said persons to develop privacy policies, to develop systems for implementing those policies and requires the protection of personal information of consumers and customers, and to provide notices to all customers. Effective November 13, 2000.

SECTION 1. This document is adopted and promulgated pursuant to the authority granted by IC 27-1-3-7 and IC 27-1-23-7.

SECTION 2. The purpose of this document is to establish the date by which persons subject to the regulation of the Indiana department of insurance must comply with the provisions of Title V of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act, 15 U.S.C. 6801 through 6827, regarding the treatment of personal information of consumers and customers.

SECTION 3. As used in this document, "commissioner" means the commissioner of the Indiana department of insurance.

SECTION 4. As used in this document, "person" means any individual, corporation, limited liability company, association, trust, or partnership.

SECTION 5. The commissioner has extended the time for compliance with Title V of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act, 15 U.S.C. 6801 through 6827, from November 13, 2000, to July 1, 2001, for persons subject to the regulation of the Indiana department of insurance.

SECTION 6. Sections 1 through 5 of this document expire February 11, 2001.
