DEVELOPMENT OF AMENDMENTS TO RULES CONCERNING PARTICULATE EMISSION LIMITS FOR KNAUF FIBER GLASS, SHELBYVILLE, INDIANA PLANT

PURPOSE OF NOTICE

The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) has developed draft rule language for amendments to rules concerning particulate emission limits for Knauf Fiber Glass, Shelbyville, Indiana plant. By this notice, IDEM is soliciting public comment on the draft rule language. IDEM seeks comment on the affected citations listed and any other provisions of Title 326 that may be affected by this rulemaking.

HISTORY

First Notice of Comment Period: March 1, 2000, Indiana Register (23 IR 1488).

SUBJECT MATTER AND BASIC PURPOSE OF RULEMAKING

This rulemaking applies to fiberglass insulation manufacturing at the Knauf Fiber Glass plant in Shelbyville, Indiana. Knauf Fiber Glass formally requested the department to reallocate their particulate emission limits in the rules and submit it as a state implementation plan (SIP) revision. The existing rule was promulgated in 1980. The proposed amendments are necessary to reflect current operations at the plant. By amending the rule, the allowable emission rate would be reduced from one hundred forty-six (146) pounds per hour to one hundred eleven (111) pounds per hour. Maximum allowable emissions would be reduced from six hundred forty-one (641) tons per year to four hundred eighty-six (486) tons per year. IDEM has modeled the potential impact of emissions from the 605 (formerly 204) furnace, the only emission point for which an increased rate has been requested. The increase, two (2) pounds per hour, has an insignificant impact on levels of particulate in the ambient air.

SUMMARY/RESPONSE TO COMMENTS FROM THE FIRST COMMENT PERIOD

IDEM requested public comment from March 1, 2000, through March 30, 2000, on alternative ways to achieve the purpose of the rule and suggestions for the development of draft rule language. IDEM received comments from the following party by the comment period deadline: Knauf Fiber Glass, (KF)

Following is a summary of the comments received and IDEM's responses thereto:

Comment: The company requests that the emission limits set out in 326 IAC 11-4-5 be modified as specified in their letter to the department dated November 3, 1998. The letter states that the proposed amendments are necessary to reflect the current operations at the plant. Changes include elimination of line 203, oven 304, and ovens 1101 through 1111, as well as renaming line 204 to line 605. (KF)

Response: The department concurs with the company and has proposed the necessary amendments to the emission limits in the rule.
