TITLE 405 OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF FAMILY AND SOCIAL SERVICES

LSA Document #00-249

Under IC 4-22-2-23, the Office of the Secretary of Family and Social Services intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Amends 405 IAC 1-8 governing reimbursement for outpatient hospital services to add a definition for essential hospital services and revise the reimbursement methodology for essential hospital services. Amends 405 IAC 1-10.5 governing reimbursement for inpatient hospital services to add level-of-care reimbursement (per diem) for long term care hospitals enrolled in the Indiana Medicaid program; adds an annual adjustment to DRG relative weights; removes date requirement for adjusting the number of residents in computing facility-specific medical education rates; provides requirements for out-of-state hospitals requesting a medical education rate, and for out-of-state children's hospitals who would like to be considered for a separate base amount. Repeals 405 IAC 1-9 (reimbursement for inpatient psychiatric services), 405 IAC 1-10 (reimbursement for inpatient hospital services), and 405 IAC 1-11 (reimbursement for services performed by physicians, limited license practitioners, and nonphysician practitioners). The repeal of these rules is a technical, nonsubstantive action. Reimbursement for these services remains available under the Medicaid program and is governed by later adopted rules that remain valid. Statutory authority: IC 12-15-21-2; IC 12-15-21-3.
