## **DIGEST**

Provides that a deer delivered to the Indiana State Board of Animal Health to be tested for Tuberculosis is not included in determining a bag limit. Effective November 17, 2000.

SECTION 1. A deer that is delivered to the Indiana state board of animal health, in order to be tested for Tuberculosis, is not counted against any bag limit otherwise applicable to the person who takes the deer.

SECTION 2. SECTION 1 of this document expires on April 1, 2001.
