Under IC 4-22-2-23, the Indiana State Board of Animal Health intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: The rule will amend requirements for control of rabies in dogs, cats, and ferrets, including requirements for transporting animals into Indiana and requirements for exhibition in Indiana. The rule will add and amend requirements for rabies vaccination of dogs, cats, and ferrets. The rule may allow dogs and cats to be vaccinated for rabies every three years under certain circumstances.
