Temporarily adds rules concerning instant game number 503. Effective January 11, 2001.
SECTION 1. The name of this instant game is "Instant Game Number 503, Lucky Slots".
SECTION 2. Instant tickets in instant game number 503 shall sell for one dollar (\$1) per ticket.
SECTION 3. (a) Each instant ticket in instant game number 503 shall contain nine (9) play symbols and play symbol captions in the game play data area all concealed under a large spot of latex material. The play symbols and play symbol captions shall appear in a matrix of three (3) rows and three (3) columns. A legend setting forth winning combinations and associated prize amounts shall appear above the game play data area.
(b) The play symbols and play symbol captions appearing in the matrix shall consist of the following possible play symbols and play symbol captions:
(1) A picture of a horseshoe SHOE
(2) A picture of a bunch of cherries

CHRY
(3) A picture of a bell BELL
(4) A picture of a pot of gold

GOLD
(5) A picture of a star STAR
(6) A picture of a gold bar BAR
(7) 7

SVN
SECTION 4. The holder of a ticket in instant game number 503 shall remove the latex material covering the nine (9) play symbols and play symbol captions. A winning play is revealed if three (3) matching play symbols are exposed on the matrix in a row, column, or diagonal entitling the holder to the prize in the amount designated in the legend. Prizes shall be available to holders of winning tickets in instant game number 503 in accordance with the following:

SECTION 5. (a) There shall be approximately four million five hundred thousand $(4,500,000)$ instant tickets initially available in instant game number 503.
(b) The odds of winning a prize in instant game number 503 are approximately 1 in $\mathbf{4 . 9 6}$.
(c) All reorders of tickets for instant game number 503 shall have the same:
(1) prize structure;
(2) number of prizes per prize pool of two hundred forty thousand $(\mathbf{2 4 0 , 0 0 0})$; and
(3) odds;
as contained in the initial order.

SECTION 6. The last day to claim a prize in instant game number 503 is February 28, 2002.
SECTION 7. SECTIONS 1 through 6 of this document expire March 31, 2002.
