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TITLE 355 STATE CHEMIST OF THE STATE OF INDIANA

LSA Document #01-48

Under IC 4-22-2.5-3, the State Chemist of the State of Indiana intends to readopt rules in anticipation of IC 4-22-2.5, providing that all rules of the Indiana administrative agencies in force on December 31, 1995, expire on January 1, 2002.
