**DIGEST**

Amends 905 IAC 1-15.2-3 to add that a minor in that part of a restaurant premises that has no bar shall be considered to be loitering unless he or she meets the currently enumerated criteria in this rule as the rule now exists. Effective 30 days after filing with the secretary of state.

**905 IAC 1-15.2-3**

SECTION 1. 905 IAC 1-15.2-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

**905 IAC 1-15.2-3 Loitering**

**Authority:** IC 7.1-2-3-7

**Affected:** IC 7.1-5

Sec. 3. A minor in **that part of** a restaurant permit premises ~~which that~~ has no bar shall be considered to be loitering unless he or she:

- (1) is accompanied by his or her parent, legal guardian, or family member who is twenty-one (21) years of age or older;
- (2) has placed an order for food and said order has not been served;
- (3) is eating; or
- (4) is viewing or listening to lawful nonparticipatory entertainment provided by the establishment; provided, however, that said entertainment may not consist solely of music, whether live or recorded.
