TITLE 65 STATE LOTTERY COMMISSION

DIGEST

Temporarily adds rules concerning instant game number 526. Effective April 27, 2001.

SECTION 1. The name of this instant game is “Instant Game Number 526, 9’s In A Line”.

SECTION 2. Instant tickets in instant game number 526 shall sell for one dollar (\$1) per ticket.

SECTION 3. (a) Each instant ticket in instant game number 526 shall contain eleven (11) play symbols and play symbol captions all concealed under a large spot of latex material. Nine (9) play symbols and play symbol captions shall appear in a matrix of three (3) rows and three (3) columns. One (1) play symbol and play symbol caption shall appear in a box labeled “PRIZE BOX”. One (1) play symbol and play symbol caption shall appear in a box labeled “BONUS BOX”.

(b) The play symbols and play symbol captions appearing in the matrix shall consist of the following possible play symbols and play symbol captions:

- (1) 1
ONE
- (2) 2
TWO
- (3) 3
THR
- (4) 4
FOR
- (5) 5
FIV
- (6) 6
SIX
- (7) 7
SVN
- (8) 8
EGT
- (9) 9
NIN

(c) The play symbols appearing in the “BONUS” box shall consist of the following possible play symbols:

- (1) \$9.00
NINE
- (2) TRY AGAIN
TRY AGAIN
- (3) PLAY AGAIN
PLAY AGAIN

(d) The play symbols and play symbol captions appearing in the “PRIZE” box shall consist of the following possible play symbols and play symbol captions:

- (1) \$1.00
ONE

- (5) \$11.00
ELEVEN
- (6) \$20.00

SECTION 4. The holder of a ticket in instant game number 526 shall remove the latex material covering the eleven (11) play symbols and play symbol captions. A winning play is revealed if three (3) play symbols of “9” are exposed in a row, column, or diagonal entitling the holder to the prize in the amount exposed in the “PRIZE” box. If the play symbol “\$9.00” is exposed in the “BONUS BOX”, the holder is automatically entitled to a prize of nine dollars (\$9). The prize amounts and number of winners in instant game number 526 are as follows:

SECTION 5. (a) There shall be approximately three million four hundred thousand (3,400,000) instant tickets initially available in instant game number 526.

(b) The odds of winning a prize in instant game number 526 are approximately 1 in 4.60.

(c) All reorders of tickets for instant game number 526 shall have the same:

- (1) prize structure;
- (2) number of prizes per prize pool of two hundred forty thousand (240,000); and
- (3) odds;

as contained in the initial order.

SECTION 6. The last day to claim a prize in instant game number 526 is April 30, 2002.

SECTION 7. SECTIONS 1 through 6 of this document expire May 31, 2002.
