TITLE 905 ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO COMMISSION

NOTE: Under P.L.204-2001, SECTION 69, the name of the Indiana Alcoholic Beverage Commission is changed to Alcohol and Tobacco Commission, effective July 1, 2001.

Under IC 4-22-2-23, the Alcohol and Tobacco Commission intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Adds 905 IAC 1-48 to establish rules requiring permittees, in all instances involving off-premise sales not conducted in a package store, to obtain proper legal identification from persons seeking to purchase alcoholic beverages.
