**EXECUTIVE ORDER: 01-13** 

FOR: EXTENSION OF THE SETTLEMENTS BETWEEN THE STATE OF INDIANA AND THE UNITY TEAM AND

THE STATE OF INDIANA AND AFSCME COUNCIL 62.

## TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, constructive and cooperative relationships among state employees and management are in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 97-33 implemented the Settlement with The Unity Team; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 97-29 implemented the Settlement with AFSCME Council 62; and

WHEREAS, Executive Orders 99-30, 99-31, and 98-11 implemented amendments to the Settlements with The Unity Team and AFSCME Council 62; and

WHEREAS, the current settlements, by their terms, expire June 30, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the negotiators for the State and the exclusive negotiating organizations have not concluded negotiations.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I Frank O'Bannon, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby order that:

- 1. The settlements are extended without interruption and do not expire until superseded by an executive order implementing successor agreements.
- 2. The settlements do not supersede any existing or future statute, promulgated rule, or executive order, however, the settlements shall be administered and construed, by those state officers and employees subject to the executive authority of the Governor, as superseding any conflicting policies and work practices.
