**TITLE 460 DIVISION OF DISABILITY, AGING, AND
REHABILITATIVE SERVICES**

LSA Document #01-334

Under IC 4-22-2-23, the Division of Disability, Aging, and Rehabilitative Services intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Adds 460 IAC 2-4, interpreter standards for the deaf and hard of hearing in educational settings, to create and specify standards of conduct and performance specific to educational settings for interpreters to persons who are deaf or hard of hearing in Indiana. It provides requirements to be met to become certified by Indiana as an interpreter to persons who are deaf or hard of hearing in educational settings. The rule will become effective 30 days after filing with the secretary of state. Statutory authority: IC 12-8-8-4; IC 12-9-2-3; IC 12-12-7-5.
