## TITLE 876 INDIANA REAL ESTATE COMMISSION

LSA Document #01-369

Under IC 4-22-2-3, the Indiana Real Estate Commission intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

**OVERVIEW:** Require licensees to obtain six hours of continuing education to reactivate an inactive license during a two year licensure period. Require a licensee who has reactivated their license to obtain ten hours of continuing education in order to renew the license at the end of the two year licensure period. Establish distance learning continuing education requirements and procedures for real estate salespersons and brokers. Establish the requirements and procedures for distance learning continuing education providers. Modify the curricula for salespersons under IC 25-34.1-9-11(1). Modify the curricula for brokers under IC 25-34.1-9-11(1). Establish the suggested outlines for mandatory courses.
