## DIGEST

Temporarily adds rules concerning instant game number 555. Effective November 1, 2001.
SECTION 1. The name of this instant game is "Instant Game Number 555, Magic Numbers".
SECTION 2. Instant tickets in instant game number 555 shall sell for one dollar (\$1) per ticket.
SECTION 3. (a) Each instant ticket in instant game number 555 shall contain eleven (11) play symbols and play symbol captions all concealed under a large spot of latex material. Nine (9) play symbols and play symbol captions representing numbers shall appear in matrix of three (3) rows and three (3) columns. One (1) play symbol and play symbol caption representing a number shall appear in the box labeled "MAGIC NUMBER", and one (1) play symbol and play symbol caption representing a prize amount shall appear in the box labeled "PRIZE".
(b) The play symbols and play symbol captions, other than those representing prize amounts, shall consist of the following possible play symbols and play symbol captions:

SECTION 4. The holder of a ticket in instant game number 555 shall remove the latex material covering the eleven (11) play symbols and play symbol captions. If three (3) of the play symbols and play symbol captions matching those in the "MAGIC NUMBER" box are exposed in a row, column, or diagonal, the holder is entitled to a prize in the amount set forth in the "PRIZE" box. The prize amounts and number of winners in instant game number 555 are as follows:

SECTION 5. (a) There shall be approximately three million six hundred thousand $(3,600,000)$ instant tickets initially available in instant game number 555.
(b) The odds of winning a prize in instant game number 555 are approximately 1 in 4.39 .
(c) All reorders of tickets for instant game number 555 shall have the same:
(1) prize structure;
(2) number of prizes per prize pool of two hundred forty thousand (240,000); and
(3) odds;
as contained in the initial order.
SECTION 6. The last day to claim a prize in instant game number 555 is November 30, 2002.
SECTION 7. SECTIONS 1 through 6 of this document expire December 31, 2002.
