## DIGEST

Temporarily adds rules concerning instant game number 579. Effective February 25, 2002.
SECTION 1. The name of this instant game is "Instant Game Number 579, Instant Slots".
SECTION 2. Instant tickets in instant game number 579 shall sell for one dollar (\$1) per ticket.
SECTION 3. (a) Each instant ticket in instant game number 579 shall contain nine (9) play symbols and play symbol captions arranged in matrix of three (3) rows and three (3) columns all concealed under a large spot of latex material. A legend shall setting forth winning plays and corresponding prizes shall appear above the matrix on each instant ticket.
(b) The play symbols and play symbol captions, other than those representing prize amounts, shall consist of the following possible play symbols and play symbol captions:
(1) A picture of a bunch of cherries CHRY
(2) A picture of an orange ORNG
(3) A picture of dollar sign MONY
(4) A picture of a star STAR
(5) A picture of a bell BELL
(6) A picture of a bar BAR
(7) A picture of the number 7 SVN
(8) A picture of a pot of gold GOLD

SECTION 4. The holder of a ticket in instant game number 579 shall remove the latex material covering the nine (9) play symbols and play symbol captions. If three (3) matching play symbols are exposed in any vertical, horizontal, or diagonal row in the matrix, the holder is entitled to the corresponding prize on the legend. The matched play symbols, prize amounts, and number of winners in instant game number 579 are as follows:

SECTION 5. (a) There shall be approximately three million six hundred thousand $(\mathbf{3}, 600,000)$ instant tickets initially available in instant game number 579.
(b) The odds of winning a prize in instant game number 579 are approximately $\mathbf{1}$ in $\mathbf{3 . 1 5}$.
(c) All reorders of tickets for instant game number 579 shall have the same:
(1) prize structure;
(2) number of prizes per prize pool of two hundred forty thousand $\mathbf{( 2 4 0 , 0 0 0 )}$; and (3) odds;
as contained in the initial order.

SECTION 6. The last day to claim a prize in instant game number 579 is March 31, 2003.
SECTION 7. SECTIONS 1 through 6 of this document expire April 30, 2003.
