## DIGEST

Temporarily adds rules concerning instant game number 576. Effective February 28, 2002.
SECTION 1. The name of this instant game is "Instant Game Number 576, Dog Gone Lucky".
SECTION 2. Instant tickets in instant game number 576 shall sell for one dollar (\$1) per ticket.
SECTION 3. (a) Each instant ticket in instant game number 576 shall contain ten (10) play symbols and play symbol captions all concealed under a large spot of latex material. Nine (9) play symbols and play symbol captions shall appear in matrix of three (3) rows and three (3) columns. One (1) play symbol and play symbol caption shall appear in a box labeled "PRIZE BOX".
(b) The play symbols and play symbol captions, other than those representing prize amounts, shall consist of the following possible play symbols and play symbol captions:
(1) A picture of a paw print

(2) A picture of a bone BONE
(c) The play symbols and play symbol captions representing prize amounts shall consist of the following possible play symbols and play symbol captions:
(1) $\$ 1.00$

(2) $\$ 2.00$

(3) $\$ 3.00$

(5) $\$ 10.00$

SECTION 4. The holder of a ticket in instant game number 576 shall remove the latex material covering the ten (10) play symbols and play symbol captions. If three (3) play symbols of a picture of a bone with the play
symbol caption "BONE" or a paw print with the play symbol caption "PAW" are exposed in a row, column, or diagonal, the holder is entitled to the prize in the "PRIZE BOX". The prize amounts and number of winners in instant game number 576 are as follows:

(c) All reorders of tickets for instant game number 576 shall have the same:
(1) prize structure;
(2) number of prizes per prize pool of two hundred forty thousand (240,000); and
