## **TITLE 312 NATURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION**

LSA Document #03-50

Under IC 4-22-2-23, the Natural Resources Commission intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

**OVERVIEW:** Would amend 312 IAC 8 that governs public use of DNR properties to make substantive and technical changes. The standards governing the use of firearms and hunting would be restructured and simplified. Service animals would be distinguished from pets, and parallel regulatory modifications would be made. In addition to a property manager, any other authorized DNR employee could allow a person to stay in a campground, for medical reasons, for longer than the ordinary time frames. A clarification would be made to when swimming is authorized on lakes located within DNR properties. Would amend 312 IAC 9 to provide that wild animals cannot be hunted or chased at a state historic site.
