TITLE 905 ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO COMMISSION

LSA Document #03-95

Under IC 4-22-2-3, the Alcohol and Tobacco Commission intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Amends 905 IAC 1-27-4 to clarify the commission's obligation to determine the desirability of the permit in regard to the general geographical location of said permit. Provides that the issue regarding location must first be raised by remonstrators, who bear the burden of proof by a preponderance of the evidence.
