Under IC 4-22-2-3, the Indiana State Board of Animal Health intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: The Indiana State Board of Animal Health is considering adopting rules that will qualify the state of Indiana for United States Department of Agriculture approval under 9 CFR 93.300 et al. to receive equine from countries or regions where contagious equine metritis (CEM) exists or where the country or region trades equine freely with a region in which CEM exists. The rules will include requirements for establishing and operating CEM quarantine stations in the state.
