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**TITLE 410 INDIANA STATE DEPARTMENT OF
HEALTH**

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Under IC 4-22-2-23, the Indiana State Department of Health intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Amends rules regarding the birth problems registry to remove birth weight less than 2,500 grams and stillbirth as reportable conditions, require reporting of both a pervasive developmental disorder and fetal alcohol spectrum disorder that is recognized in a child before five years of age. Amends the maximum age of a child whose diagnosis must be reported to the registry and whose report must be included in the registry from two years to three years. Statutory authority: IC 16-38-4-7.
