LSA Document #05-41

Under IC 4-22-2-23, the Indiana State Board of Animal Health intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: The rule will update and amend rules relating to the control of diseases in sheep and goats including the disease scrapie. The proposal will address identification of animals and premises, testing, record keeping, monitoring and surveillance, requirements for positive, suspect, and exposed animals, epidemiology, requirements to move interstate and intrastate, restrictions on sales and other transfers, exhibition requirements, and other disease control measures. The proposal may include scrapie certification of animals and flocks.
