Under IC 4-22-2-3, the Indiana State Board of Animal Health intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: The rule will establish a state system allocating premises identification numbers for premises associated with certain animals, animal related enterprises, and meat and poultry and dairy products production. The rule will add a requirement that a person obtain a premises identification number prior to buying, selling, or exhibiting certain livestock and require a person holding a livestock exhibition to register the event with the state veterinarian and keep records. Partially effective 30 days after filing with the Secretary of State and partially effective January 1, 2006.
