Under IC 4-22-2-23, the Indiana Department of Administration intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

**OVERVIEW:** To establish rules to regulate (1) the traffic and parking of motor vehicles, bicycles, or other vehicles; and (2) the traffic of pedestrians on the streets, roads, paths, and grounds of real property controlled by the state through the department in and around the state capitol, office buildings, parking garages, and adjoining state controlled property.
