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TITLE 856 INDIANA BOARD OF PHARMACY

Under IC 4-22-2-23, the Indiana Board of Pharmacy intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Adds 856 IAC 1-40 to implement rules based on Senate Enrolled Act 590 (P.L.204-2005) to establish definitions, standards, and requirements for electronic transmissions of prescriptions, including addressing the privacy protection for the practitioner and the practitioner's patient, the security of the electronic transmission, a process for approving electronic data intermediaries for the electronic transmission of prescriptions, use of the practitioner's United States Drug Enforcement Administration registration number, and protection of the practitioner from identity theft or fraudulent use of the practitioner's prescribing authority.
