Under IC 4-22-2-23, the Indiana Pesticide Review Board intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

**OVERVIEW:** Adds 357 IAC 1-12 to establish definitions for the term drift and other related terms and to prohibit anyone from applying a pesticide in a manner that results in drift of the pesticide from the target site in sufficient quantities to cause harm to a nontarget site.
