TITLE 312 NATURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION

LSA Document #06-67

Under IC 4-22-2-23, the Natural Resources Commission intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Amends 312 IAC 25 that assists in the administration of IC 14-34 (sometimes referred to as the “Indiana Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act” or “I - SMCRA”) that governs surface coal mining and reclamation activities. Amends 312 IAC 25-4-102 to require an applicant proposing to establish commercial forest resources on prime farmland to submit for approval a commercial forest planting plan, commercial forest management plan, and documentation of landowner consent. Amends 312 IAC 25-6-143 to allow commercial forest resources on reclaimed prime farmland provided soil productivity is demonstrated according to soil productivity standards.
